Invited into the Beautiful Love of the Trinity

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—is not something to be solved, but someone to be known, loved, and entered into. Our readings for this coming Sunday speak of divine wisdom present before creation, and we are reminded that God's love is poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, and we are gently drawn into the life of God—not as spectators, but as much loved participants.

Jesus reveals to us a God who is not distant or abstract, but deeply relational. In this coming Sunday's Gospel, Jesus promises the Spirit who will guide us into all truth, sharing what is from the Father and the Son. This truth is not merely information; it is the truth of God's own self-giving love. As St Augustine once said, "If you understood it, it would not be God" (Sermon 117). God is far beyond the limits of our minds, but never beyond the reach of our hearts

The icon of the Trinity by Rublev beautifully portrays the three divine Persons in unity and mutual love. Their communion is not closed, but open - inviting us in. In Jesus, we are drawn into this divine relationship, so that love and wisdom may not only transform us but flow through us to others.

To encounter the Trinity is to encounter a love so perfect that it overflows for the good of all creation. As we celebrate this solemnity, may we respond with humble wonder, seeking to love Jesus, the Father, and the Holy Spirit more deeply. Let us allow this divine love to shape our relationships and heal our world—for our good and for the good of all creation.

In the Book of Genesis, we hear these very significant words: "So God created humankind in His own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them." (Genesis 1:27). This foundational truth reminds us that to know God is, in a real way, to know ourselves—who we are and who we are called to be.

Sacred Scripture is the greatest source we have for deepening our understanding of God. While not the only way we come to know God, Scripture offers us the clearest window into God's heart, God's promises, and God's call in our lives.


