Dear wonderful Parishioners of St Benedict's Parish

Happy St Benedict's Feast Day!!

We have awesome scriptures this Sunday offering us a beautiful invitation to open our hearts to the life-giving power and love of God's Word. Through the prophet Isaiah, God assures us that His Word is never empty or ineffective. Like the rain and snow that fall upon the earth, watering the soil and bringing forth abundant life, God's Word always accomplishes the purpose for which He sends it (Isaiah 55:10-11). God is continually sowing His love into our lives. The question is not whether God is speaking, but whether we are listening.

Jesus develops this same theme in the Parable of the Sower (Matthew 13:1-9). The Sower scatters the seed generously and without discrimination. Some seed falls on the path, some among rocks, some among thorns, and some into rich soil where it bears an abundant harvest. The difference is never the quality of the seed, for the seed is always God's life-giving Word. The difference lies in the condition of the soil, that is, in the condition of our hearts.

How fitting these readings are as we celebrate our **St Benedict's Feast Day Mass this Sunday at 8:30am**. One of St Benedict's most treasured teachings is, "Listen with the ear of your heart." Fifteen centuries later, his words remain just as relevant. When we listen deeply to God in prayer, in Sacred Scripture, and through one another, our hearts become fertile soil where God's Word can take root, grow and bear lasting fruit.

This Sunday we will be celebrating our **St Benedict's Feast Day at our Sunday 8:30am Mass**. Our Feast Day is one of the three great celebrations of our parish family each year, together with our vibrant Multicultural Pentecost Mass, and our Parish Anniversary Mass, celebrated on the Sunday closest to 3 December. Our Feast Day Mass will include **special processions** celebrating the richness and diversity of our parish, **followed by a wonderful parish feast** where everyone is warmly invited to stay, share a meal, and strengthen the friendships that make St Benedict's such a welcoming community. Please bring a plate to share at this feast after Mass if you can.

St Paul, in his Letter to the Romans, St Paul reminds us that although our world still experiences suffering, hardship and uncertainty, creation itself longs for the fullness of God's Kingdom. We, too, wait with joyful hope, knowing that God is at work bringing about something far greater than we can presently see. Every act of love, every prayer, every kindness, every sacrifice offered in faith is a seed planted for eternity.

What a joy it is to witness this taking place each week in our own parish. So many parishioners generously give themselves in participating in the life of the parish. These acts may seem small, but in God's hands they produce an abundant harvest for His Kingdom.

One beautiful example of this spirit has emerged from our recent St Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal. Inspired by the generosity already shown, one of our parishioners suggested that caring for those in need become an ongoing part of our Sunday worship. **Beginning last weekend**, parishioners are **invited to bring a non-perishable food item** to Mass each week. **A basket will be placed at the back of the church before Mass**, where your donation can be placed as you arrive. **During the Offertory Procession these gifts will be brought forward with the bread and wine before being donated to St Vincent de Paul.**

As we celebrate our patron, may we ask St Benedict to help us listen with the ear of our hearts. May God's Word find within each of us rich soil, producing a harvest of faith, hope and love. And may our parish continue to be a community where people encounter Jesus, discover the joy of belonging, and bear abundant fruit for the glory of God.

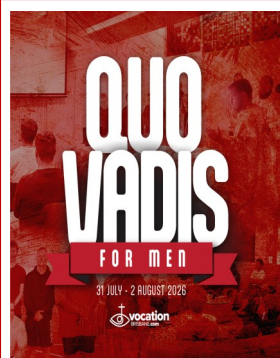

We thank all of our Planned Givers for their generous financial support of the St Benedict's Parish, every little bit helps, and it is appreciated greatly.



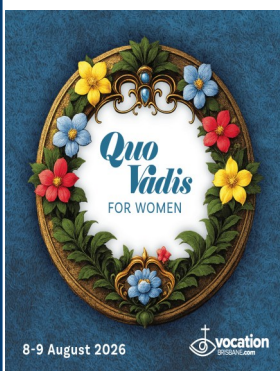

Baptism at St Benedict's.

We invite all families wishing to have children (up to 12 years) Baptised into the Catholic Faith at St Benedict's, to please contact the Parish Office for information and available dates for our Baptism Preparation and Baptism in 2026.

Children's Sacramental Programs

We encourage families wishing to enroll children to receive their Sacraments, or for those seeking further information about our Annual Sacramental Programs, to please contact the Parish Office via email.

Eligibility to receive the Sacraments:-

Confirmation - children in Grade 3 and above having already received the Sacrament of Baptism are eligible.

The Program for Confirmation takes place throughout the months of July and August each year.

First Holy Communion (Eucharist) & Reconciliation - children in Grade 4 and above, having already received the Sacrament of Confirmation are eligible.

The Program takes place throughout the months of May and June each year.

RCIA and RCIT

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA, 18yrs and above) and The Rite of Christian Initiation of Teens (RCIT, 13-17 years) Programs run annually.

The program runs for approx. 12-15 weeks from November through to Easter the following year, with a small break over the Christmas & New Year period.

Justice Peace & Ecology Noticeboard.

One purpose of the Justice Peace and Ecology Ministry is to help promulgate to the Parish important words from the Holy Father. Our major challenge is still to "Get the Laudato Si message out." In the extensive 2015 Encyclical of Pope Francis, "On Care for Our Common Home" he exhorted everybody to care for our planet, and told how the real losers in environmental degradation are the marginalised and poor. Each one of us can help make a change, but we must look beyond the four walls of our church.

Emma Beach, Archdiocese Executive Officer, helped us finalise our Parish Laudato Si Action Plan. It is now very simple to follow. We will be presenting the plan to Father and then to the Parish in the next few weeks.

Emma holds regular meetings for all northside parishes at Bracken Ridge. We usually have 3 or 4 participants. Last Saturday's discussions focused on:

- Laudato Si' Week actions and plans for 2027
- Integral Ecology in the Life of the Family document - how to use in the future
- Pope Leo's Magnifica Humanitas
- Catholic participation in encouraging the signing of the Fossil Fuel Treaty.

Afterwards, Emma said, "There was so much we covered and so much we could discuss more. Our next Northside Gathering is on the 1st August. **Please invite others from your communities to mark this time in their calendar.**" Anyone is welcome, contact Ken if you are interested.

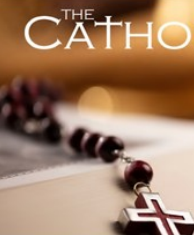
