The Holy Trinity

Often, when I am talking to the children about God, I go from talking about Jesus to talking about the Holy Spirit, which gets us moving into Trinity territory. Whenever this happens, I put on the brakes and say something like, "we believe that God is the Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who we say whenever we bless ourselves with the sign of the Cross." Then I just go back to talking about Jesus.

Our Trinitarian God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – is not the easiest concept to understand. We will never fully understand the Trinity, because to fully understand God we need to be God. St Augustine affirmed this when he said, "If you understood, then what you have understood is not God." Also, St Thomas Aquinas puts the incomprehensibility of God like this, "The most we can know of God during our present life is that He transcends everything we can conceive of Him" (De Veritate).

While God is transcendent, God also walks among us and chooses to reveal Himself to us. Jesus is the Divine Word made flesh, who lived among us and who promised us the Spirit of Truth, who will lead us to the complete truth. It is the Holy Spirit who enables us to have a relationship with the Risen Jesus, and it is through our relationship with the Risen Jesus that we get to know and understand God more and more. This is how we know that God loves us and wants to be in relationship with us, and wants God's love to permeate through our whole selves into our relationships with all things. Living a beautiful life in the love of the Trinity, glorifying God, and giving glory and praise to God forever.

Covid-19 is Still Very Contagious

Unfortunately, there are members of our parish community who are catching Covid-19, and I would not be surprised if it is being caught at one our Masses. Now that restrictions are eased, our Masses do have the potential of being super-spreading events. **So, please may we refrain from coming to Mass if we have any cold or flu symptoms, and may we wear a mask, socially distance, and sanitise our hands regularly to prevent the spreading of this very contagious virus.**

Mask wearing at Masses is now optional, and there will no longer be capacity limits at our Masses.

However, to include our parishioners who are at risk of being very adversely affected by Covid-19, **we will set up an area of the Mass Centre to be Covid-safe. That means this area will be reserved for parishioners who are vulnerable and would like to maintain social distancing and wear masks.** I urge you to follow the recommendations following to do all we can to keep each other safe during these times of reduced restrictions.

**** Please stay home if you are sick or showing signs/symptoms of illness.**

**** Wearing a mask is recommended when you cannot socially distance.**

**** Please maintain good hand hygiene.**

**** Please do not shake hands, hug, or kiss hello. These actions are not COVID safe.**

Smoke Free School

A reminder to all Parishioners and Friends that smoking is not permitted within school grounds. The law relating to school land applies at all times - during and after school hours, on weekends and during school holidays.
