In light of some issues we have been experiencing with the Parish Office phone line, we have implemented an additional phone number to be able to contact our Parish Office on. Christian Meditation - The Peace of Christ.

I encourage us all to read the following pearl of wisdom from the Benedictine priest Fr John Main OSB, who is highly accomplished in the area of Christian Meditation. This wonderful ancient form of prayer is unquestionably invaluable for us all today. Enjoy!

The task of meditation is to bring our distracted mind to stillness, silence and awareness. Meditation helps to quieten our mind. The Psalmist said, 'Be still, and know that I am God.' (Psalm 46;10) To achieve this aim we use a very simple device. It is one that St. Benedict drew to the attention of his monks by directing them to read the Conferences of John Cassion (Rule of St Benedict 42:6, 13-73, 14.). He suggested we take a single short verse, or word, and just repeat this verse over and over again. The simple and constant repetition of this sacred word is the best way of casting out all distractions and chatter from our mind, in order that it might rest in God (Fr. John Main, OSB, Word Into Silence).

Receiving Holy Communion

During one of the training sessions, some of the ministers expressed concern that some parishioners do not consume the Blessed Sacrament immediately after receiving Jesus. So could those parishioners who are not consuming the Body of Christ immediately after receiving Him, please do so.

Hymns at Mass

Unfortunately, we are still waiting for an imported part, which will fix the projectors in our Mass centre. We have decided to choose three hymns (Opening hymn, Communion hymn, and Recessional hymn) to be sung at our Masses each week until the projector is repaired. These hymns will be printed and laminated and handed out at our Masses. We will collect these laminated sheets and sanitise them at the end of each Mass. This is to encourage everyone to participate in the singing at our Masses. For as St Augustine says, "When we sing, we pray twice."

Unfortunately, there are members of our parish community who are catching Covid-19, and I would not be surprised if it is being caught at one our Masses. Now that restrictions are eased, our Masses do have the potential of being superspreading events. So, <u>please</u> may we refrain from coming to Mass if we have any cold or flu symptoms, and may we wear a mask, socially distance, and sanitise our hands regularly to prevent the spreading of this very contagious virus.

Thank you so much for your ongoing commitment to keeping each other safe.




Valentine's Concert 2022
