### Christians Do Not Ignore their Sisters and Brothers in Need

In this coming Sunday's Gospel we hear Jesus' story about Lazarus at the gate. Lazarus was a poor man, who begged for food at a rich man's gate. The rich man ignored the poor man completely, doing nothing at all to help him.

This is another lesson in discipleship that Jesus is giving us as we join Him on the road to Jerusalem, the road to the cross. The cross, of course, is the great symbol of self-giving, the giving of ourselves totally to God, Who will always call us and give us the strength to pour ourselves out completely to God and to each other.

In Jesus' story about Lazarus at the gate, Jesus makes it very clear that as disciples of Jesus we are called to be alert to those suffering around us, and to do all we can to help them. This is very much a part of joining Jesus in healing the world.

Each year from September 1 to October 4, the Christian family unites for the Season of Creation, a worldwide celebration of prayer and action to protect our common home. Our wellbeing is interwoven with the wellbeing of the Earth and we rejoice in this opportunity to safeguard our common home and all who share it.

This year, the theme for the season is Listen to the Voice of Creation. We continue to listen to Pope Francis' message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. This is week 4 of the Season of Creation, and here is the fourth and final key point of Pope Francis' message:

### Four key principles for biodiversity

Pope Francis uses his message to call on nations to halt the further collapse of the "web of life" – biodiversity – pointing to four principles:

- Building a clear ethical basis for the transformation we need in order to save biodiversity;
- 2. Fight biodiversity loss, support its conservation and recovery, and meet people's needs in a sustainable way;
- 3. Promote global solidarity, taking into account that biodiversity is a global common good that requires a shared commitment; and

Put people in vulnerable situations at the centre, including those most affected by biodiversity loss, such as indigenous peoples, older people and youth.
