# This Week's Readings, 4th September

#### Called to Take Up our Cross and Follow Jesus

I met a bloke the other day, who use to be a highly paid executive for the National Australia Bank. He's now retired, plays a lot of golf, spends time with his wife and grandchildren, has a yearly corporate box at the Gabba to watch the Brisbane Lions games, and is a director of two companies, both publicly listed. One of these companies impressed me greatly, while the other company's product is less impressive, and an interesting reflection on society.

The first company provides imaging technology that allows health care professionals to rapidly detect whether someone has had a stroke, and if there is any bleeding in the brain. This is awesome technology that will enable ambulance personnel to treat stoke victims immediately, minimising the damage caused by the stroke.

The other company provides storage facilities for people to store material possessions. This company makes a much greater profit than the first one, which is somewhat ironic given that the brain imaging technology is far more beneficial to humanity.

In the last line of this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says, "none of you can be my disciple unless you give up all your possessions' (Luke 14:33). In light of the storage companies making huge profits in the Western World today, I dare say that there are not too many disciples of Jesus, for people are clearly hoarding possessions that they are not even using. While at the same time, many people go without. Let us be inspired by St Francis of Assisi, St Ignatius of Loyola, and many other saints, who freed themselves from their abundant material possession, and devoted their lives to Christ, who always calls us to look after the poor.



Each year from **September 1 to October 4**, the Christian family unites for the **Season of Creation**, a world-wide celebration of prayer and action to protect our common home. Our wellbeing is interwoven with the wellbeing of the Earth and we rejoice in this opportunity to safeguard our common home and all who share it.

This year, the theme for the season is **Listen to the Voice of Creation.** 

For the first time, Pope Francis has published in advance his <u>message</u> for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, which is celebrated every September 1. It marks the beginning of the <u>Season of Creation</u>.

For the next four weeks we will summarise the four keys points of Pope Francis' message.

#### This is week 1: A time to cultivate our ecological conversion

The Pope defines the Season of Creation as "an opportunity to cultivate our 'ecological conversion'", recalling this concept encouraged by St. John Paul II as a response to the 'ecological catastrophe' announced by St. Paul VI as early as 1970.

In this way, he invites all Christians during this time to "pray once more in the great cathedral of creation, and revel in the "grandiose cosmic choir" made up of countless creatures, all singing the praises of God."

People of faith, says the Pope, feel "even more responsible for acting each day in accordance with the summons to conversion. Nor is that summons simply individual: "the ecological conversion needed to bring about lasting change is also a community conversion".

# Decree 7 of the Fifth Plenary Council of Australia is titled: AT THE SERVICE OF COMMUNION, PARTICIPATION, AND MISSION: GOVERNANCE

**Article 1** That dioceses support parishes to establish and strengthen appropriate synodal structures by developing guidelines and providing resources for the flourishing of Parish Pastoral Councils, Parish Finance Committees, and other parish bodies.

Article 2 That representatives from the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference, Catholic Religious Australia and the Association of Ministerial Public Juridic Persons form a working group to conduct appropriate and broad consultation, to develop and establish a National Catholic Synodal Life Roundtable, to foster, assess, and report periodically on the development of synodal leadership across the Church in Australia. The roundtable will bring together representative members of those groups with Diocesan Pastoral Councils and other key national bodies of the Church, including Catholic social and community services, health, and education.

**Article 3** That the National Centre for Pastoral Research be commissioned to study the implementation of recommendations from The Light from the Southern Cross which has already happened, to identify examples of effective initiatives that have been taken and thus promote further implementation of those recommendations judged helpful and practicable


