## Today you will be with me in Paradise (Luke 21:19)

Over the last several Sundays, the readings have expressed great hope in how awesome life is in the next world. Firstly, St Paul in his second letter to Timothy describes dying as setting sail into the sunset and being received into the loving arms of God (2 Timothy 4:6).


Then Jesus, two weeks ago, in a conversation with the Sadducees, makes it clear that the children of God will be like the angels when we go to heaven (Luke 20:36). Then in last week's Gospel, Jesus encourages us to hold firm to our faith on earth, no matter what we are confronted with in this life, for in the next life "not a hair on our heads will be lost, and our endurance will win us eternal life" (Luke 21:19).

In this coming Sunday's Gospel, Jesus continues this theme on the Feast of Christ the King. While Jesus is suffering from His brutal execution by crucifixion, there is a beautiful encounter between Jesus and the criminal being crucified with Jesus, who speaks up for Jesus. He asks Jesus to remember him when Jesus comes into God's Kingdom. And Jesus responds, 'Indeed, I promise you, today you will be with me in paradise' (Luke 23:43). Beautiful comforting words, not only for the repentant criminal, but for us all.


## Second Rite of Reconciliation
