Mary and Joseph – Humble People of Faith

Each year, the spotlight is placed on our heavenly Mother, Mary, for the Fourth Sunday of Advent. This makes perfect sense given that this is the Sunday before we celebrate the Birth of our Lord. In Sunday's Gospel, however, the spotlight is also placed on Mary's husband, Joseph. Joseph, as portrayed in this Gospel, is a wonderful humble person of faith, as is his wife Mary.

We all know Mary's beautiful humble words when the Archangel Gabrielle asks her to be the Mother of God — "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord, let it be done to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38). Similarly, when God speaks to Joseph through an angel in a dream, Joseph immediately does what God asks of him to do when he wakes up from the dream. Like Mary, Joseph puts God at the centre of his life, and does whatever God asks of him. Building Extension of the Primary School Hall.

The St Benedict's Primary School have an exciting building project where they are extending their hall. This, however, will impact us while the construction is taking place. The project has started as you will see on arrival at the Mass Centre.

We were able to acquired more information last week from the builders of the project, and it is likely that the completion date will be May/June (dependent on the weather etc). During December/January (possibly February also) there will be **no Friday Masses**, and the hall will only have **one entry/exit point**, **which is the one stacker-door next to the tennis courts at the front of the Worship space** (the two emergency doors at the front of the hall will be used in emergency situations only).

So, the only difference for us is that we will be entering and exiting the hall through the stacker-door at the front of the hall rather than the back of the hall (as we have been doing ever since Covid times). Given that the front stacker-door is closer to the car park, this will be more convenient for many parishioners.


