## Advent - Joyful Waiting for the One We Love

In last Sunday's Gospel we heard Jesus encouraging us to be watchful and alert to the coming of Jesus into our lives. Similarly, this Sunday's Gospel has John the Baptist crying out that the Kingdom of God is very close at hand, and to prepare the way for the Lord. Eliminating any barriers that are preventing us from journeying through life with Jesus.

Advent is a time where we prepare ourselves to receive Jesus, Our Saviour, into our lives more deeply. Advent is the expectant waiting, hopeful anticipating and cheerful preparation of God breaking into our lives in all moments, all places, and all times — past, future, and present. Where we commemorate the birth of Jesus, prepare for Jesus' return, and welcome God into our lives every day. Advent prepares us for all these events and reminds us there is a joy in waiting.

To mark this special season, we are making two changes to our Sunday Masses during Advent. Firstly, each week we are going to sing the hymn "Come, Emmanuel" as the Processional hymn, with the refrain being sung again after the Penitential Act. Then secondly, music will be played continuously while the Prayers of the Faithful are read, and after each prayer there will be a sung call and a sung response (Call: "Lift up o Church this world to God." Response: "Come quickly Lord in mercy come."). This is a beautiful way of reminding us that we are in the Advent season preparing ourselves to joyfully receive the One we love more deeply into our lives when He comes.

#### Building Extension of the Primary School Hall begins

The St Benedict's Primary School have an exciting building project where they are extending their hall. This, however, will impact us while the construction is taking place. The project **starts on Monday the 5<sup>th</sup> of December** and will continue for approximately 3 months, or until completion. During this time there will be **No Friday Masses.** 

It is also important for Mass goers to note, that the hall will only have <u>one entry/exit point</u>, that is the one stacker-door next to the tennis courts (at the front of the Worship Space). We ask that you please do not enter any fenced off construction areas during the coming months. Thank you.


## Cathedral of St Stephen, Advent Concert Series - 5PM Sunday 4 December.

Dominic Perissinotto, St Stephen's Cathedral Organist, will perform French composer Olivier Messiaen's *La Nativité du Seigneur* (The Nativity of the Lord), a work of nine "meditations" each depicting an image or concept from the birth of Jesus. *La Nativité* is a testament to Messiaen's Christian faith, as well as one of his earliest works to show the style of composition that would later imbue much of his music. His works were inspired by both the mountains and the nativity scenes in stain glass windows in medieval cathedrals.

In addition to Dominic's performance, Archbishop Mark Coleridge will present reflections on each movement, delving into the joy of Christ's birth, and relating the music to the artwork of Sophie Hacker, which will be displayed on monitors during the performance. Sophie worked with 'found objects' - discarded pieces of wood, string, metal and skip finds, and created nine stunning images depicting aspects of the Incarnation, which are full of spiritual and theological symbolism.

- If the you are required to hold or renew your Blue Card/ Police Check, our Parish Office will be in contact with you directly. Thank you.


