At the heart of the Centre's offerings are four core modules entitled Catholic Foundations. The first module is "Catholic Theology in Context" and will commence on February 20th, 2023 on Monday evenings.

Recognising the limits of human understanding and experience, this course explores the spiritual and physical nature of the human person, the infinite nature of God, how God has been revealed to humanity, and how relationship with God is experienced and lived. Please, may we continue to keep each other and ourselves safe by :-

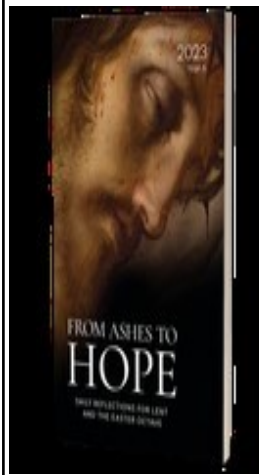
