I am the Resurrection and the Life (John 11:25)

With Easter fast approaching, we have a very appropriate Gospel for this coming Sunday, the death and resurrection of Lazarus, which points us to the death and resurrection of Jesus. Showing us that God has absolute and unconditional control over life and death. However, the very significant difference is that, unlike Lazarus, who has only resumed his physical earthly life again, Jesus was raised to a newness of life where death no longer threatens Him. Jesus' resurrection conquers death, not just for Jesus, but for us all.

This is reinforced by St. Paul in this coming Sunday's second reading where he says, "if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in us, then he who raised Jesus from the dead will give eternal life to our own mortal bodies through his Spirit living in us" (Romans 8:10-11).

The restoration of Lazarus to physical human life is a symbol of the eternal life which Jesus, as the Resurrection and the Life, comes to impart to us all. Let us open our hearts and minds to Jesus, so we can receive this great and wonderful gift!

Financially Supporting Our St Benedict's Parish

Thank you to everyone who filled in the pledge cards last weekend and are contributing financially to the life of our St Benedict's Parish. Sadly, the response was not overwhelming, which puts us in a relatively weak position in asking the Archdiocese to build us a church. Also, I am not sure what we are going to do when the Archdiocesan funding reduces.

Once again, a huge thankyou to the parishioners who do contribute to the financial well-being of the parish. Without you we would not be able to operate as a parish.

I urge you to please consider - Financially Support Our Parish

Due to good financial stewardship, and the generosity of those who have supported fundraising initiatives, we have now been able to use surplus funds to repay the loan on the Presbytery. This goes a long way to show that the parish is becoming financially viable, and that further support from the Archdiocese is warranted to support our mission for the construction of a church.

Since being established as a parish, we have been very fortunate to receive over \$100 000 support from the Archdiocese of Brisbane to assist with the running of our parish. This support, however, is due to cease next year, that is, in 2024.

The only stable and recurring income that our parish receives is from parishioners who **support our Planned Giving Program**. At present, we are not receiving enough income from our Planned Giving to meet the financial cost of running the parish.

This is a constant challenge for us, as costs will rise sharply once we have a church. With the income from the Archdiocese in the future certain to stop, we need to step up as a parish.

There is a need to increase our collections by \$2000 a week in-order-to plug the gap when we are no longer eligible to receive the current level of subsidies from the Archdiocese. Also, as I have said, after a church is built there will be additional operating costs such as insurance, maintenance, utility bills etc.

This weekend once again I am asking every parishioner to commit some of your **TREASURE** and help make our dream become a reality.

Each family will receive a Parish Pledge Card asking everyone to **commit to the Planned Giving Program.** If you are already in the Planned Giving Program, we are asking you to at least continue and if possible increase your financial support. At the moment around 500 people attend Mass each week and only 70 families contribute to the Parish through the Parish Planned Giving Program.

If you are not yet part of our Planned Giving Program, then please join and make a commitment. The pledge card gives us three (3) options to financially contribute to the running of the parish. These are:
