Grasping the Trinity

I have been receiving Spiritual Direction for over twenty-five years. This is a process where I sit face-to-face with a Spiritual Director, who gets me talking about my relationship with God.

Now, I am not sure about other people who receive Spiritual Direction, but I seem to be very good at putting my Spiritual Directors to sleep. Throughout my years of Spiritual Direction, I've had seven Spiritual Directors, and all seven, I have put to sleep.

Six of my Spiritual Directors were relatively young priests, so to put them to sleep is a good effort. My other Spiritual Director was a priest in his eighties, and he didn't just fall to sleep while I was speaking, he would actually fall to sleep while he was speaking too. He would say, "Well Bryan, I want you to reflect on the parable in Luke's Gospel where..." And he would give this big pause, and I would be looking at him, thinking, is he trying to find words, then, after a while I'd realise that he had actually fallen asleep. I wasn't sure what to do!

This elderly Spiritual Director was a marvellous man, and he gave me a pearl of wisdom that I will never forget. He often said to me, "Bryan, we will never be able to get to know and understand God fully. For to be able to get to know and understand God fully, we would need to be God. And God help us if we were God."

So, if you struggle in understanding the Trinity, then join the club. For to fully understand the Trinity, is to fully understand God. And we need to be God to be able to do that.

We can only seek to get to know and understand our Trinitarian God more and more. We do this by living our lives in the grace of God, as our constant companion on the journey of life, who always leads us to true life. In other words, we don't try to grasp God, we allow God to grasp us. And it is by living our lives intentionally in the great presence of God, we will be able to know and love God more and more, and come to realise that God fully knows and loves us infinitely.

The 68 hectares of the largest open space between Pine River and Narangba, (old North Lakes golf course) was legally zoned in 1998 as "Open Space – Residential Uses Prohibited". It is a critical wildlife habitat and corridor, and a vital recreational area. It is now under grave threat to be redeveloped into high density residences. Please stop this by objecting now.

Update on the Church

As mentioned in previous weeks, significant members of the Archdiocese, BCE and I are regularly meeting to discuss our church. We have decided to move closer to having a church. We joined together again last Thursday (25/05), to discuss and plan for the next steps to be taken.

The next steps that are to be taken will be to have a new Master Plan drawn up for the future of the St Benedict's Primary, College and Parish and the use and development of the block of land across from the Primary School hall. Along with this Master Plan will be a feasibility exercise as to whether a New Build, a Pre-Fabricated or Re-establishing/relocating an existing church building onto the land would be accessible and most affordable.

In the meantime, I am organising a Parish Church Futures Group to assist in progressing towards building our church, and to develop a strategy looking at how our parish will fund it.

Financially Supporting Our St Benedict's Parish

To everyone who actively contributes financially to the life of our St Benedict's Parish. Thank you! Without you we would not be able to operate as a parish.

We know that the only stable and recurring income that our parish receives is from the support of our Planned Giving Program. At present, we are not receiving enough income from our Planned Giving to meet the financial cost of running the parish.

There is a need to increase our collections by \$2000 a week in-order-to plug the gap when we are no longer eligible to receive the current level of subsidies from the Archdiocese, which will cease in 2024. Also, as I have said, after a church is built there will be additional operating costs such as insurance, maintenance, utility bills etc.

Please, I am asking every parishioner to commit some of your TREASURE and help make our dream become a reality. Our Parish Pledge Card is available at the Mass centre; asking everyone to commit to the Planned Giving Program. If you are already in the Planned Giving Program, we are asking you to at least continue and if possible increase your financial support. 500 people on average attend Mass each week and we have 83 families that contribute to the Parish through the Parish Planned Giving Program.

If you are not yet part of our Planned Giving Program, then please join and make a commitment to our Parish. There are three (3) options to financially contribute to the running of the parish. These are:
