Our Call to be Merciful to Others.

Many scholars see the Gospel for this Sunday as being the central passage of Matthew's Gospel. In this Gospel Jesus gently and graciously invites us to always come to Him, but especially during tough times in our lives. For a key theme in Matthew's Gospel is that God is a God of mercy, a God who saves.

Matthew presents Jesus focussing primarily on the weightier matters of the Old Testament, that is, on justice, mercy and peace. Twice in the Gospel, Jesus says, "What I (God) want is mercy, not sacrifice" (Matthew 9:13, and 12:7).

Each week we come together to celebrate the sacrifice of the Mass. Joining Jesus on the Altar in offering ourselves up in sacrifice totally to the Father and to others. But we do this in vain, according to Jesus, if we do not follow it up by being people of justice, mercy, and peace as we live our lives. For Jesus says, "Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy" (Matthew 5:7).

The celebrations will continue after Mass with morning tea. All are Welcome!

No Sunday 5.30pm Mass - This Sunday July 9th.

Please note that there will be no 5:30pm Mass on Sunday July 9. This is to enable all parishioners to participate in our feast day Mass lead by Archbishop Mark.

The Liturgy is the Source and Summit of the Christian Life (SC 10)

The above quote comes from a Second Vatican Council document Sacrosanctum Concilium, which is the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (to view this excellent document on the liturgy pleased click <u>Sacrosanctum concilium (vatican.va</u>).

We are blessed to have Elizabeth Harrington continuing to educate us this week, as we learn more about the Prayer of the Faithful at Mass.

Prayer of the Faithful.

The Liturgy of the Word ends with the Prayer of the Faithful or Universal Prayer.

The Prayer of the Faithful is actually not a prayer addressed to God at all but a series of intentions that worshippers are invited to pray for. The pattern of the Prayer of the Faithful is:

- * The presider begins by addressing the faithful and inviting them to pray.
- * The intentions are read out, using a form of words such as "Let us pray for/We pray that...".

The faithful pray about the announced intentions in the pause that follows each one. The petitions only become the 'Prayer of the Faithful' when we, the faithful, respond to the invitation, formulate a prayer in our hearts and bring them together in the "Lord, hear our prayer".

For example, if the reader says: "We pray for those experiencing violence or hunger or homelessness", each of us prays in silence for those we are aware of in those situations – perhaps for the people of Ukraine, or in Yemen where there is famine, or for the homeless in our own city.

- * After a cue (e.g. "Lord, hear us"), the community responds together (e.g. "Lord, hear our prayer").
- * The presider concludes with a collect that sums up the prayer of the assembly.

Receiving from the Chalice.

We are now allowed to receive Holy Communion from the Chalice at our Masses. However, we need volunteers to be Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion of the Chalice specifically. This role will involve:

- * distributing the Chalice at our Masses,
- * consuming the Blood of Christ remaining, and
- * purifying the vessels.
