If at First You Don't Succeed, Try, Try Again!

In my homily at my Dad's funeral, I said that my Dad was a man of sayings. While Dad was having his final days in the Palliative Care Unit at Redcliffe Hospital, my Mum, my siblings, and myself were writing down all of Dad's saying. We accumulated over 100 sayings. Then in my homily at my Dad's Funeral Mass, I focussed mainly on the biblical saying that he would often quote.

As I read this coming Sunday's Gospel, one of Dad's favourite sayings kept popping up in my head. That is, "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again!" This is certainly what the Canaanite Woman did in persistently asking Jesus to heal her daughter who was tormented by a devil. There is an absolutely beautiful scene in this Gospel, where after shouting her request many times and being ignored by Jesus, "the women had come up and was kneeling at Jesus' feet. "Lord" she said, "help me" (Matthew 15:25). Jesus rejects her again, but she persists. Jesus is blown away by the love that the Canaanite woman has for her daughter, and of her faith in Jesus. "Jesus answered her, 'Woman, you have great faith. Let your wish be granted.' And from that moment her daughter was well again" (Matthew 15:28).

So, inspired by the Canaanite Woman's faith, if at first we don't succeed, try, try again!

This week Elizabeth Harrington is explaining the significance of having collections at Mass.

THE COLLECTION

In the early years of Christianity, the faithful brought bread and wine with them to church to be used in the celebration of the Eucharist. What wasn't used at the Mass was given to the poor and needy. Later, people started bringing other gifts of food or money which were offered for the work of the Church.

In most parishes a collection of money is taken up during the Preparation of Gifts. This action is an integral part of the liturgy because our offering links us to the sacrifice of the cross and

Archbishop Mark Coleridge Committed to an Indigenous Voice (from the Catholic Leader 15 February, 2023)

BRISBANE Archbishop Mark Coleridge has spoken out in support of creating an Indigenous Voice to parliament, ahead of an Australian referendum on the subject later this year.

"I'm strongly committed to the Voice. I've listened to important and convincing indigenous voices on this topic," Archbishop Coleridge said.

In September 2021, Archbishop Coleridge publicly endorsed the Uluru Statement From the Heart and made an historic commitment on behalf of the Catholic Church to back indigenous leaders demanding a constitutional voice.

His endorsement was founded on Scripture and a history of dispossession of First Nation peoples.

"God is going to take out of us that heart of stone and give us a heart of flesh – the heart of Jesus... that recognises the other as a human being," Archbishop Coleridge said, standing on Quandamooka country at the Santa Teresa Spirituality Centre in Ormiston, east of Brisbane.

"What has been done to the indigenous peoples of this land could only have been done by denying that they were in fact human – they were at best perhaps subhuman.

"A heart of flesh says no to that, absolutely no."

Australia's first Catholic mission was established in 1843 on Stradbroke Island, not far away, and on Quandamooka Country.

Receiving from the Chalice.



" Dear XXXX


Can you set aside a minute? I'm trapped in a meeting and need you to perform a task for me. Cannot speak, need to meet now, so just write back here. Sincerely,

Financially Supporting Our St Benedict's Parish To everyone who actively contributes financially to the life of our St Benedict's Parish. Thank you! Without you we would not be able to operate as a parish.

We know that the only stable and recurring income that our parish receives is from the support of our Planned Giving **Program**. At present, we are not receiving enough income from our Planned Giving to meet the financial cost of running the parish.

There is a need to increase our collections by \$2000 a week in-order-to plug the gap when we are no longer eligible to receive the current level of subsidies from the Archdiocese, which will cease in 2024. Also, as I have said, after a church is built there will be additional operating costs such as insurance, maintenance, utility bills etc.

Please, I am asking every parishioner to commit some of your TREASURE and help make our dream become a reality. Our Parish Pledge Card is available at the Mass centre; asking everyone to commit to the Planned Giving Program. If you are already in the Planned Giving Program, we are asking you to at least continue and if possible increase your financial support. 500 people on average attend Mass each week and we have 83 families that contribute to the Parish through the Parish Planned Giving Program.

If you are not yet part of our Planned Giving Program, then please join and make a commitment to our Parish. There are three (3) options to financially contribute to the running of the parish. These are:

1. Direct Debit or 2. Credit Card or 3. Giving Envelopes On this Pledge Card we will have an opportunity to support both:
